Lesson 1: Why Read the Bible?

Q. How do you struggle, or in what why do you struggle to get more out of your Bible reading or to read your Bible better?

I. Why should we read the Bible? (look at verses)

- A. Psalm 14:1-2 God exists
- B. Deuteronomy 32:4; Psalm 66:3 God is perfect, majestic, and awesome in all of His ways
- C. Genesis 1:1-2:3; Isaiah 45:5-7; Colossians1:15-17 God created and sustains all things
- D. Genesis 1:26-28; Isaiah 43:6-7 God made us in His image
- E. 2 Timothy 3:16-17 God has revealed Himself to us in Scripture

Bottom Line: God exists. He made all things for His glory. He has revealed Himself in Scripture.

II. Why Do We need the Bible?

- A. We read Scripture so that we know the good news of Jesus Christ. 1 Corinthians 15
- B. We read Scripture so God will transform our lives. Romans 12:1-2
- C. We read Scripture so we will trust our Savior more fully. Romans 8
- D. We read Scripture to preserve unity among God's people. Ephesians 4:1-17
- E. We read Scripture to guard sound doctrine. Titus 2:1
- F. We read so we will know how to love and serve our brothers and sisters. Hebrews 10:24-

25

- G. We read the Bible so that we can love God and be transformed more and more into the image of His son. (Romans 8:28-29; 2Corinthians 3:18).
 - 1. This means we so delight in God's Word (Ps. 1,119).
 - 2. And because there is no greater joy than knowing God (Ps. 16:11).
